well as completing a project implementation plan;

WHEREAS the RMC has made changes to the plan to include the

recommendations of the Ministry of public security to comply with

its commitment to respect and achieve it;

WHEREAS the Municipality of Sheenboro has seen the final version of the

revised "Fire safety cover plan" from the Pontiac RMC.
