### A. Joann McCann

Mrs. McCann presented to council the vision for the Nature Conservancy of Canada Hiking Trail. She informed council that the theme for the trail was "Footprints Through Time". Her vision is to involve the schools so that they may have some educational outings at the trail. The "Loggers Trail" sign along with several others were also presented to council.

### 6. Director Generals Report

The gravel has been laid on Fort-William Road and reshaped by the grader. The culvert extensions on the same road should be completed within the next few weeks. Brushing is completed and all the budgeted money allowed has been spent.

Had a site visit with the engineer regarding the Sullivan/Perrault Road refurbishment project and everything went great. Engineer confirmed additional weepers were needed on the hill on Perrault Road. The culvert at the bottom of the hill on the right side does not need to be replaced but does need to be cleaned out properly to allow the flow for the following spring. The ditch will be dug out again at the bottom of the hill before the culvert as a lot of sand has accumulated. The engineer has suggested adding bails of hay to slow down the sand.

A meeting was had with Mr. Vincent Donato regarding his concerns about the ditching done on Sullivan Road near his property. The engineer was consulted and the additional, deeper ditching Mr.Donato was requesting was not recommended because the engineer said they cannot change the water course and with a bell line in the way they also cannot dig deeper.

All culverts were inspected by the engineer for the TECQ project and everything was good. Additional stones to cover some culverts on Sullivan Road has been requested from the engineer.

A culvert was missed during the original road inspection for the project just before Brennan's Bluff Road and has been included to be changed to a slightly smaller culvert. The cost will be covered by the 10% contingency money for the project.

At the bottom of trout lake road, across Mountain Road, the engineer has requested further ditching of 20 metres to ensure the overflow of water does not end up in the field.

### 7. Foreman's Report

### A. Road Report / Monthly Report

Gravel has been placed on Fort-William Road. Stones need to be removed from Sheen Road. The culvert on Fort-William Road will need hardtop. Transfer site is ready for the large item drop off days. Culvert at Downey's Bay needs to be taken out. Roads will need to be graded one more time before the winter. Brushing is complete on Meehan and Fort-William Road. High-volume culverts have been cleared and are ready for the spring. Ramp at the municipal building has been stained.

The municipality undertakes to be solely responsible and to release the Government of Canada and the Government of Quebec as well as their ministers, senior officials, employees and agents from any liability regarding claims, requirements, losses, damages and costs of all kinds based on injury inflicted on a person, death of that person, damage to property or loss of property attributable to a willful or negligent act resulting directly or indirectly from investments made with the aid financial obtained under the TECQ 2019-2023 program;

The municipality approves the content and authorizes the sending to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing of the attached work schedule version n ° 1 and all other documents required by the Ministry in order to receive the government contribution that was confirmed to him in a letter from the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing;

The municipality undertakes to reach the minimum threshold of fixed assets imposed on it for all of the five years of the program;

The municipality undertakes to inform the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing of any modification that will be made to the work schedule approved by this resolution.

The municipality hereby certifies that the attached work schedule n ° 1 includes true costs as well as estimated costs of eligible work.

- WHEREAS, if the rendering of accounts is deemed to be compliant, the Minister makes a payment to the municipalities according to the list of work he has approved, without however exceeding the maximum amount of assistance as it appears literally announcement;

WHEREAS the other sources of funding for the work have been declared;
